#### Student Enrichment Activities


Students had opportunities to participate in the local and district Spelling Bee, Christmas Play, Spring Concert, and the local and regional Science Fair.

#### Curriculum Development

Using a variety of resources and instructional strategies, students advanced their literacy in all subject areas with emphasis on incorporating one-to-one devices in the upper elementary grades. Grants and gifts were secured to purchase and install a firewall and upgrades to internet infrastructure. Learning outside the classroom was encouraged as students participated in field trips to local farms, U of M Extension Office, MLC Children's Theater, NU Cathedral, State Capitol, MN Science Museum and others. Iowa Test of Basic Skills results show our students scored in the 60-85% percentile compared to their peers nationwide in Math and Reading.
