

2016 St. Anne's School Marathon

This year marks the 44th Annual Marathon for Nonpublic Education. Our school prides itself on offering low tuition allowing any student the opportunity to attend. The purpose of the marathon is to raise money to help cover a portion of the school's operating costs, allowing you affordable tuition. The marathon also gives us the opportunity to showcase to the community our school spirit and pride, working together to support the quality education of our Catholic school.

How the Marathon Process Works:

As a key event for our overall fundraising, the student goal has been set to raise \$17,000. This is just \$200 over our last year's earnings. We strive to have 100% student participation so please make every attempt to participate, both in seeking pledges and participating in the marathon itself. Asking family, friends, neighbors, and co-workers to make a pledge is imperative. New this year and in addition to requesting pledge donations, donors may choose to include a prayer intention along with their donation. These intentions will be offered up by our students and parishioners during Mass the day of the marathon. *Start seeking pledges on Fri. Sept. 16.*

Pledges & Prayer Intentions

Use the back side of this sheet (blue) to record your pledge donations. All pledge money must be collected and returned to school no later than Friday, Oct. 7. Ask the donor if they would like to offer a prayer intention which we will offer up at Mass on marathon day. The intention should be recorded on the gold sheet.

Prayer intentions must be turned into the school office by Sept. 30 to be offered at the Mass.

Marathon Day:

The marathon will be held, rain or shine, on **Sunday, Oct. 2** following 10 AM Mass at St. Anne's Church. Students walk a designated 2 mile route (4-6 grade with an adult chaperone have the option to bike a 4 mile route). All family, friends, and parishioners are invited to join in the day's events for exercise and fellowship. First Aid personnel will be available throughout the route. A potluck dinner, with hamburgers and hotdogs provided by the Catholic Order of Foresters, will be held at the end of the walk/bike in the church social hall.

Marathon Goals and Rewards:

To encourage a successful campaign, a 3-tier incentive has been designated as follows:

- \$17,000 (student pledges only) – Zooman Reptile & Amphibian Lyceum on Oct. 20.
- \$19,000 (student pledges only) – "Blindfolded Chefs" activity featuring Fr. Tony and Mr. Davis
- \$23,000 (student pledges, matching grants, and all other donations) – Free Day/No School on Holy Thursday, April 13.

AND

- The class raising the most money per student will enjoy a "game hour" with Fr. Tony at a time to be determined by Fr. Tony and the class.
