

# 2018 St. Anne's School Marathon

This year marks the 46th Annual Marathon for Nonpublic Education. Our school prides itself on offering low tuition allowing any student the opportunity to attend. The purpose of the marathon is to raise money to help cover a portion of the school's operating costs, allowing you affordable tuition. The marathon also gives us the opportunity to showcase to the community our school spirit and pride, working together to support the quality education of our Catholic school.

## **How the Marathon Process Works:**

As a key event for our overall fundraising, the student goal has been set to raise \$21,000. We strive to have 100% student participation so please make every attempt to participate, both in seeking pledges and participating in the marathon itself. Asking family, friends, neighbors, and co-workers to make a pledge is imperative. Continuing the tradition, in addition to requesting pledge donations, donors may choose to include a prayer intention along with their donation. These intentions will be offered up by our students and parishioners during a designated Mass following the marathon. *Start seeking pledges on Fri. Sept. 14.*

## **Pledges & Prayer Intentions**

Use the attached sheet (blue) to record your pledge donations. All pledge money must be collected and returned to school no later than 10 am **Thursday, Oct. 4**. Ask the donor if they would like to offer a prayer intention which we will offer up at our school Mass the following week. The intention should be recorded on the back side of the pledge sheet.

## **Marathon Day:**

New this year, the marathon will be held, rain or shine, on **Friday, Oct. 5** at 9:30 AM. Students and staff will make a 2 mile pilgrimage through the city of Wabasso, stopping at various locations to pray a decade of the Rosary. All family, friends, and parishioners are invited to join us. In the afternoon and assuming we reach our goal, students will celebrate as follows.

## **Marathon Goals and Rewards:**

To encourage a successful campaign, a 3-tier incentive has been designated as follows:

- \$21,000 (student pledges only) – Obstacle course & movie
- \$23,000 (student pledges only) – Fr. Tony challenge

AND

- The class raising the most money per student will enjoy a "game hour" with Fr. Tony at a time to be determined by Fr. Tony and the class.
